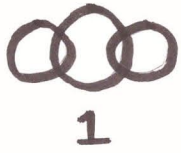
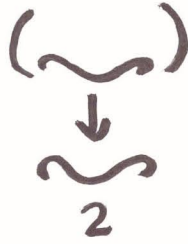


Nose



1
Draw three overlapping circles, making the middle one larger than the others.



2
Use these circles as guidelines to draw this line. Draw two curved lines on the sides of the nostrils.



3
Add a long, slightly curved line to indicate the bridge of the nose (notice it is a bit to the side). I also like adding a smaller curve indicating the peak of the nose.

* Note how when I draw my nose, my lines are indications of shapes and I am not trying to deliberately enclose shapes.

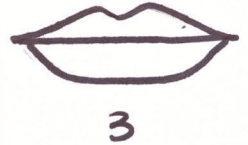
Lips



1
Draw this line. Practice if you have to!



2
Draw a horizontal line below your initial line indicating the opening of the mouth.



3
Add your bottom lip!

* When drawing males, my trick is to start out with a less curved initial line and to simply not enclose shapes completely. This makes the lips less defined and feminine. Sort of like this:
